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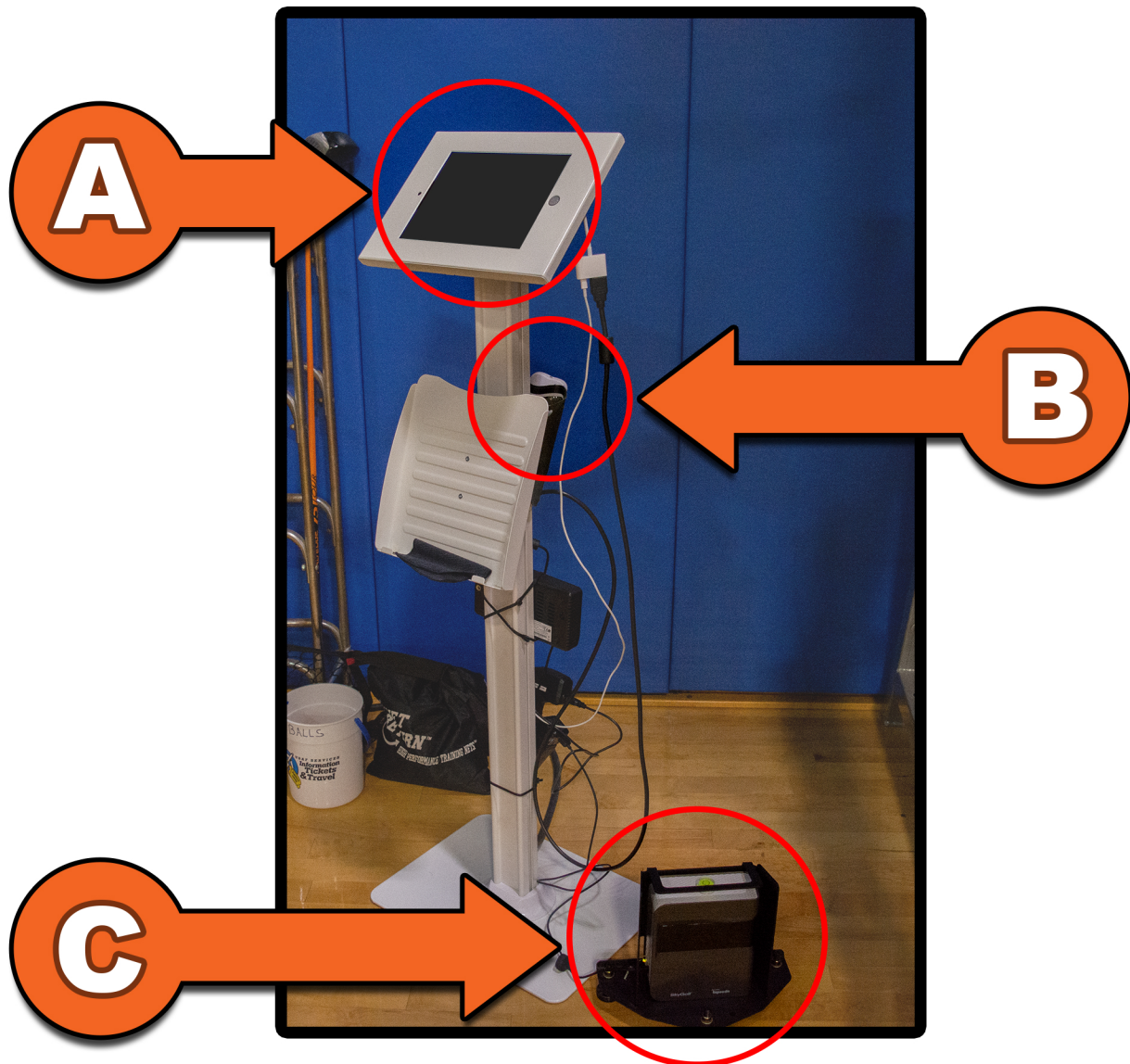
Additional Settings

Step 1 - Locate The Control Center

Next to the golf simulator you will notice a white stand. This white stand will house 3 major components to the golf simulator. Here you will find the control screen, remote for the projector, and sensor device.

- A** **Control Screen** - The Control screen is where you will control the specifics you are wanting to do within the simulator.
- B** **Projector Remote** - The projector remote can be found on the back side of the stand and allow you to turn off and on the project.
- C** **Sensor Device** - The sensor device for the simulator can be found at the base of the stand charging.

Important Note: When you are finished using the simulator you will need to place the sensor back to this position and plug it back in to recharge.



Step 2 - Turn On The Projector

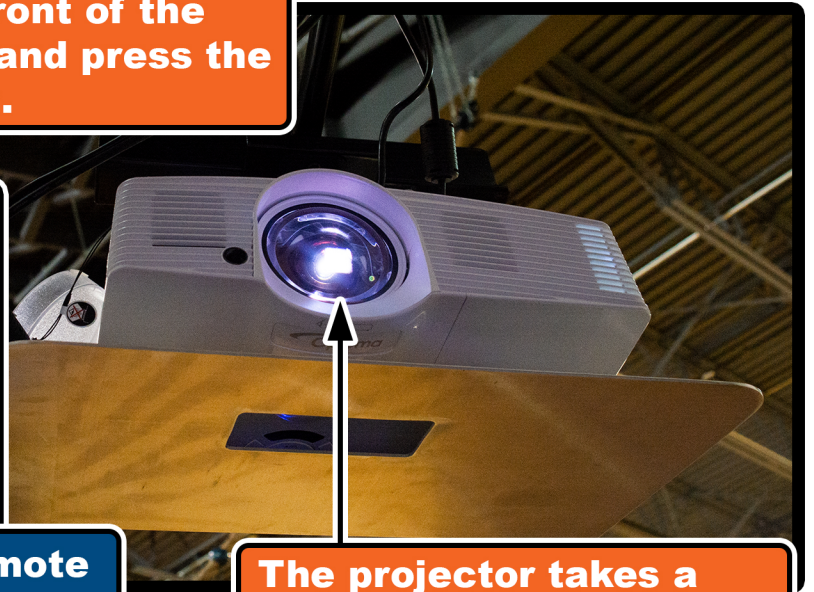
Once you have found the 3 major components you will want to go ahead and turn on the projector with the projector remote. The Projector remote can be found hanging on the back side of the stand.

A

Stand in front of the projector and press the ON button.



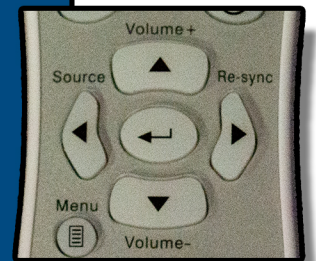
The remote lights up when in use.



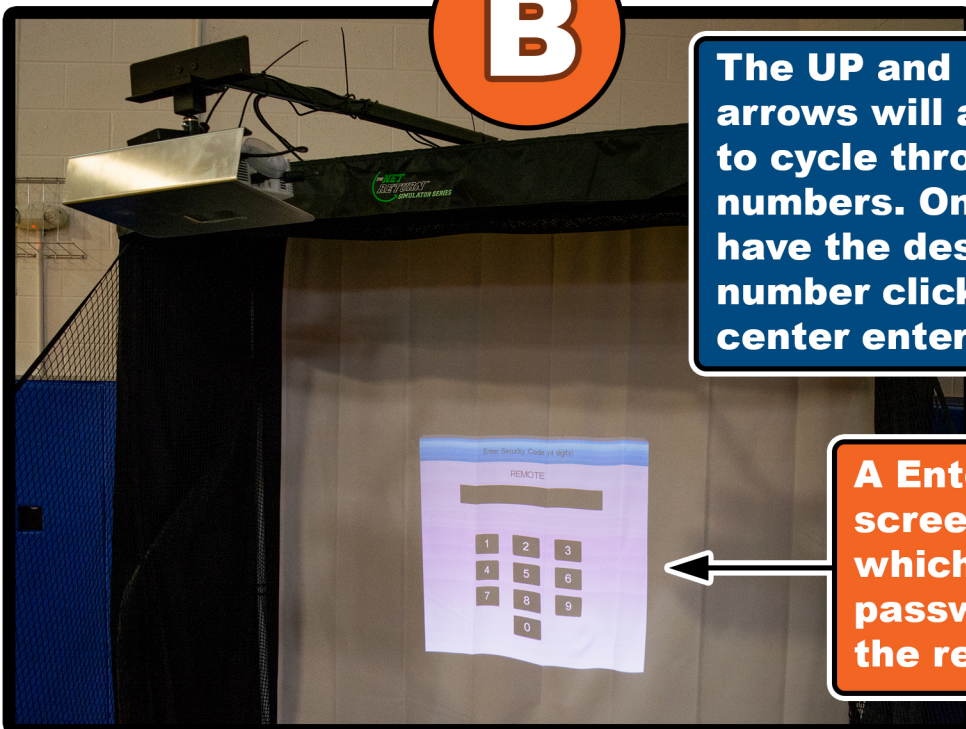
The projector takes a moment to warm up but you should see it start to light up.

B

The UP and Down arrows will allow you to cycle through numbers. Once you have the desired number click the center enter button.



A Enter Password screen should appear in which you will enter the password "1234" using the remote.



Step 3 - Launch The App

Now it is time to launch the app that you will be using for the simulator.

A



If the screen is grayed out you will want to click this button.

The password for the control screen is the same as the projector "1234".

Click the "ST" app icon.

B



When you first open the app everything will show up grayed out until everything connects. Be patient as this may take a moment.

Once connected click the Practice Option.



Once everything is connected you should see both the "Practice" icon and the "Sensor" icon light up

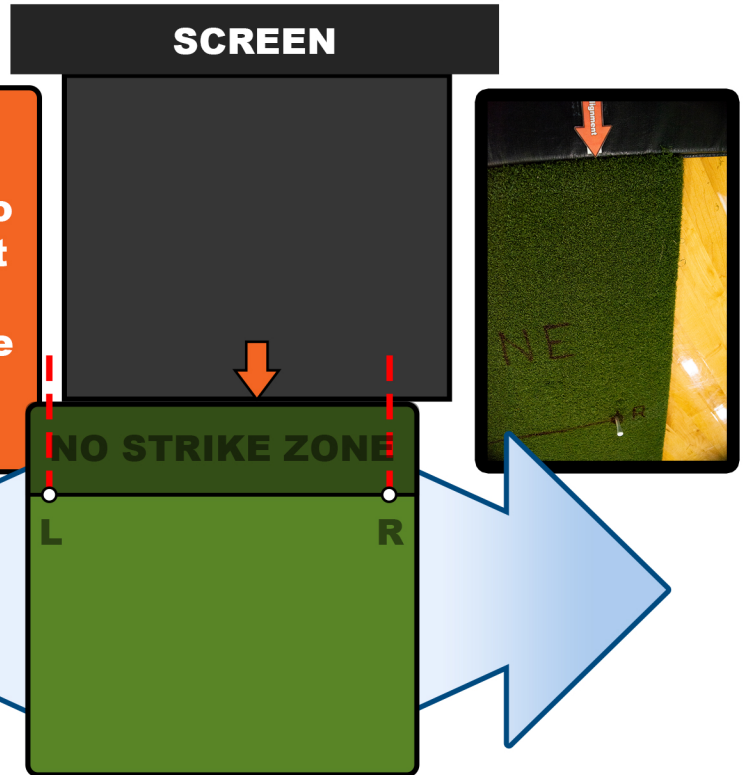
This is the Practice interface which you should see mirrored on the projection screen.

Step 4 - Platform & Sensor Setup

Now that the app is launched you will want to take a moment to setup the platform and then the sensor.

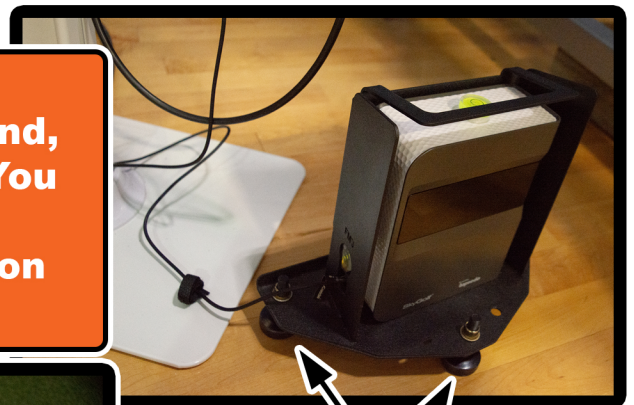

Depending on if you are shooting right handed or left handed you will want to move the green mat so that it lines up with the orange Tee Alignment arrow on the black mat in front of the screen

The Sensor Device, which is located at the bottom of the stand, should be plugged in charging. You will want to unplug the Sensor device and then make sure it is on and level.



The level indicator is on the top of the device. You can make adjustments by adjusting the 3 legs of the device.

Step 5 - Practice Options & Sensor Placement

With your platform and sensor ready to go you will now need to decide what type of practice shot you are wanting to work. Once you have decided you will need to adjust the sensor accordingly.

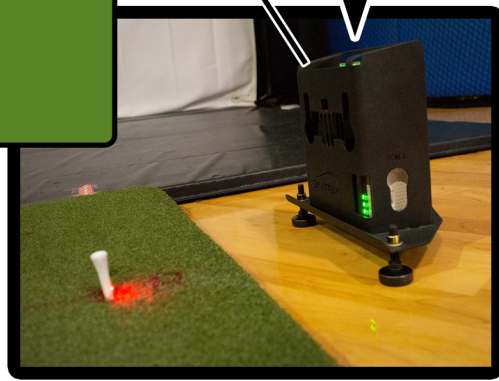
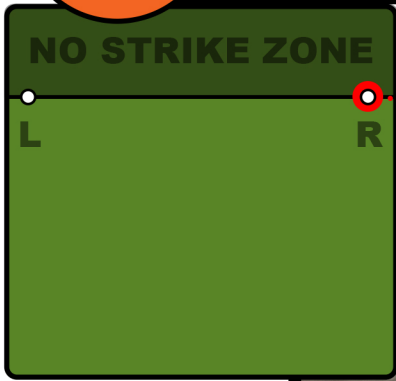


2 Select Your Club.

1 Click the circle icon to select your club.

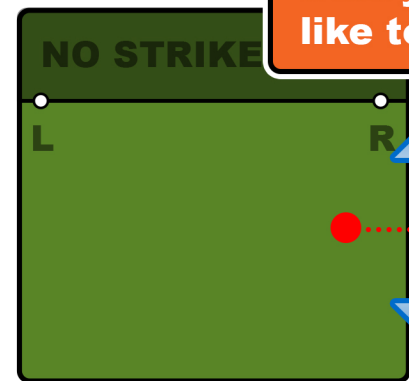

For tee shots place the sensor to the side of the tee with the red laser shining at the base of the tee.



C

Now for none tee shots move the sensor closer to the green and position it closer or further away from the screen depending on the shot you would like to take.

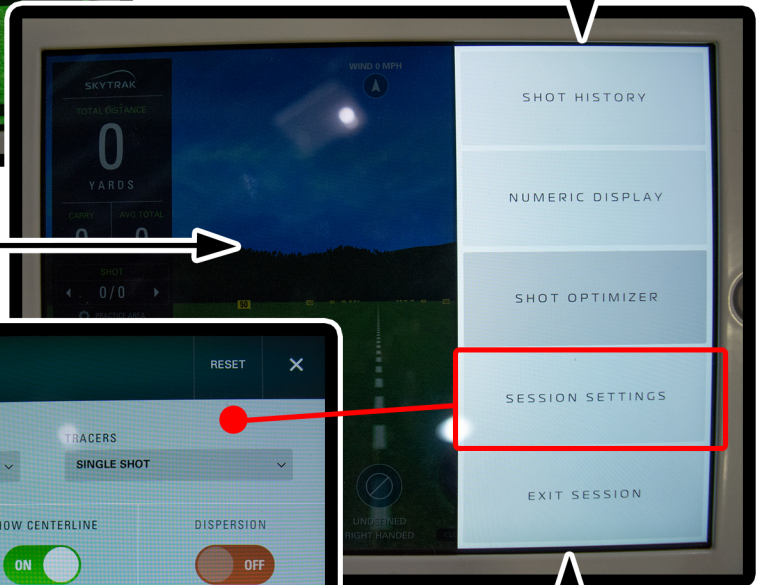


Step 6 - Additional Settings

To make some adjustments to the setting or to exit out completely simple follow the example below.



Click on the lines in the upper right corner to open up a menu system



Click on the screen to the left of the menu to go back.

In this menu you can also exit out.

Here you can choose if you are shooting Left or Right handed.
